- CLAS-E C&D paper-based testing includes free scanning of DRC answer sheets directly into the DRC INSIGHT portal, just like you do for TABE 11&12 and TABE 13&14
- Scanning becomes much easier and more economical—no need to purchase Scantron scanners or expensive software
